- Each has similar authority & primary responsibility for regulating stationary sources of air pollution in its district

Grants and Incentives

Objectives:

- Promote purchase of cleaner-than-required equipment before regulation requirements
- Achieve real, lasting, targeted emission reductions
- Ease business transition costs

They do not:

- Incentivize uncertified equipment
- Exceed cost-effectiveness or other program limits
- Pay 100% of total project costs



Clean Air for All Grants

Opening Early 2023

- Heavy Duty Equipment and Infrastructure
 - MOYER – Diesel Equipment
 - Trucks, agricultural equipment, marine vessels, off-road equipment, cargo handling equipment
 - Infrastructure eligible - projects that provide alternative fuel or power in support of program-covered sources.
 - Stationary Source - Projects located in disadvantaged communities, including hexavalent chromium plating facilities or any stationary source categories approved by CARB
 - Clean Air Protection Program – Identified environmental justice areas
 - FARMER – Agricultural Equipment
 - Zero Emission Truck Pilot – Specific to AB 617 Portside Area
